  - a. Teacherage grant proposal The board members discussed how they were excited for something to happen on the lot. It will look a lot better, and they are happy to see it being put to good use. Raymon added that he hopes it will attract some families to the community. Motion to approve the proposed project and agreement with the county Motion: Lori Tait, Second: Sonya Kimball, passed unanimously.
  - b. Contract with Incredibuild, general contractor, for building teacherage Tyler advised the board members of the approximately \$61k in dirt work that needs to take place on the property in addition to the contract price. The board members had a brief discussion about clay and other conditions that can necessitate the need for excavation work. Raymon was concerned that the bid included all of the concrete flatwork. Tyler indicted that the contractor confirmed that this was included in the bid. Motion to approve the contract with INCREDIBUILD to construct the teacherage duplexes at the contract price plus the additional amount for earth work/excavation.
